

Assignment 1: The Miracle of the Day

T 1 B 4a. ALL miracles mean Life, and God is the giver of Life. He will direct you VERY specifically.

This assignment invites you to look for the "miracles" in your everyday life. It's about finding the extraordinary in the ordinary. About the 'cues' you recognize.

Focus on the "ALL miracles mean Life" and "He will direct you VERY specifically" parts of the quote. The goal is to notice the small, often-overlooked moments that feel like a gift or a specific direction.

Instructions:

- For one week, carry a small sketchbook or journal with you.
- Document at least three "miracles" you witness. This could be anything—the way light hits a leaf, a kindness from a 'stranger', a perfectly-timed song on the radio, or a new idea that pops into your mind and gives you a sense of connection..
- Each day, create a small piece of art in response to one of these moments. This could be a quick sketch, a short poem, or a collage of found objects. The art should capture the feeling of that specific moment.
- At the end of the week, choose your favorite moment and create a final, larger piece
 of art. This could be a painting, a sculpture, a photograph, or a mixed-media piece.
 The final work should be a more complete representation of that specific miracle,
 showing how it felt like a direct gift or guidance.
- **Submission:** Present your final piece along with your sketchbook to share your lovely discovery.
